Selamat Sempurna (SMSM IJ)

Buy (Maintained)

A Solid Quarter As Expected; BUY

- **Keep BUY and IDR2,250 TP (31% upside), c.8% yield.** Selamat Sempurna's solid 2Q26 performance met our expectations. We believe the company will continue to see strong demand in 2H26, from both domestic and overseas markets. It also announced a second interim dividend, in line with our expectations. We like SMSM for its resilient earnings, strong profitability and balance sheet, and attractive dividend outlook. Key risks: Higher raw material costs, fuel price volatility, export disruptions, and delays in EV local content regulations.
- **Strong 1H26 net profit.** 2Q26 net profit of IDR303bn (+21.8% QoQ, +13.9% YoY) brought the 1H26 figure to IDR551bn (+3.8% YoY), at 45% of our FY26 estimate (in line). The strong 2Q26 performance was supported by a recovery in revenue as well as profitability during the quarter.
- **Robust sales to continue.** 2Q26 revenue of IDR1.4trn (+15.1% QOQ, +8.9% YoY) was driven by robust demand in the domestic market, as well as still-strong demand in its overseas markets (especially Asia and the US). Domestically, SMSM is set to benefit from the recovery in auto production volumes and implementation of the Government's B50 biodiesel programme (which we believe will boost demand for heavy equipment oil filters). It should also see a demand boost from the Merah Putih Village Cooperative (KDMP) programme, which requires procurement of commercial vehicles and dump trucks (we believe SMSM, as a prominent domestic body maker, will benefit from this). We expect revenue to strengthen further from 2H26 onwards, with another key catalyst from the requirement to increase local content (especially for foreign manufacturers) coming into effect from FY27.
- **Profitability to remain strong** as the company has managed to adjust its ASPs in both domestic and overseas markets in 2Q26 (by 3-5% across its products). We expect this move to help it maintain its profitability in the current elevated input cost environment, giving SMSM the opportunity to increase its profits when input costs eventually ease.
- **Second interim dividend.** The company will distribute IDR40 per share in line with its commitment towards disciplined dividend payments distributed four times per year. This is in line with our expectations. The cumulative date is set for 6 Aug, with the recording date on 10 Aug and payment on 27 Aug.
- **ESG.** Our TP includes a 0% ESG discount/premium, as SMSM's ESG score of 3.0 (out of 4) is on par with the country median.

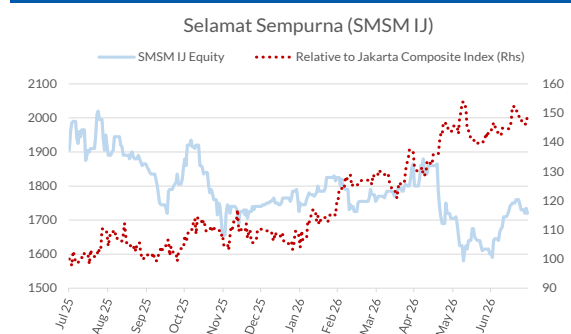

Trend analysis

SMSM's aim is to manage its Scope 1 and 2 greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions through energy efficiency initiatives. It currently operates on an effective 100% non-renewable energy mix, and applies the 3R principle to manage hazardous and non-hazardous waste. It also plans to strengthen resilience by diversifying towards non-engine products, ie EV filters, heating, ventilation and air-conditioning (HVAC), and industrial filtration.

Latest ESG-Related Developments

To manage GHG emissions, SMSM applies energy efficiency principles to lower fuel and electricity consumption, in line with Indonesia's target to have national net-zero emissions by 2060. It has applied 3R principles in the following ways: i) Replacing trichloro ethylene with RDL solvent (ie reduce), ii) Reusing adhesive material packaging ("reuse"), and iii) reprocessing production plastic waste ("recycle").

SMSM treats its production wastewater through an 80cu m per day wastewater treatment plant to meet environmental quality standards.

SMSM runs an environmental management system and applies the 3R principle to its waste, recycling 3,902.72 tonnes in 2025 with no chemical spills.

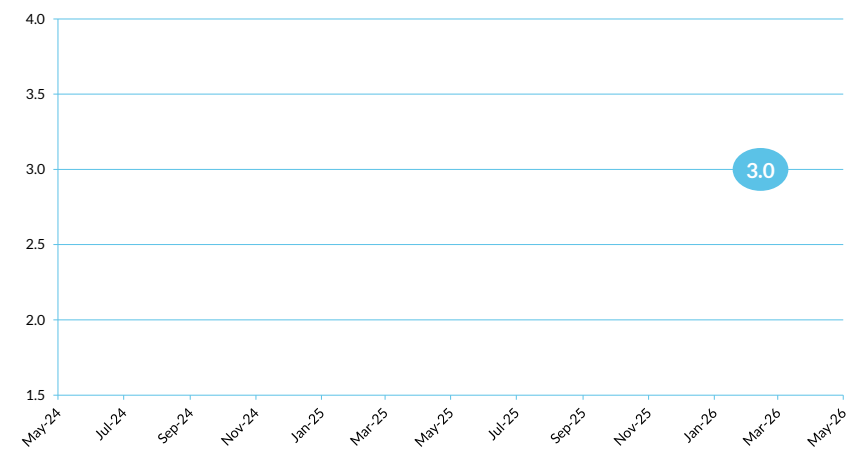

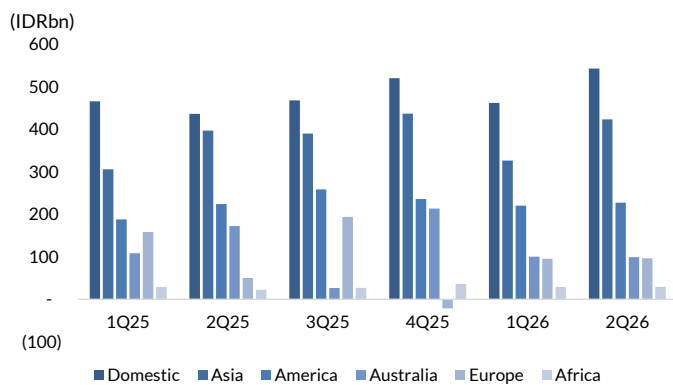

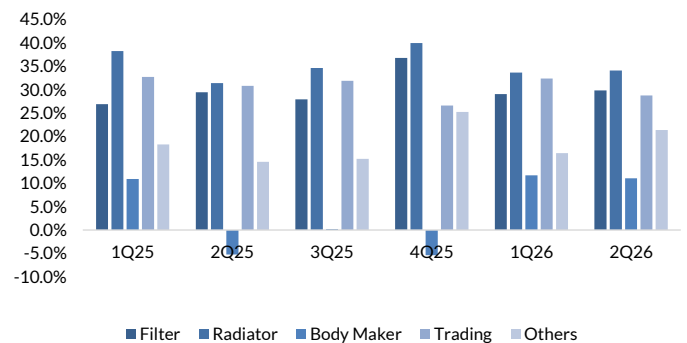
